

## What is a wasp?

A wasp is a small insect with wings.



Wasps are yellow with black stripes and have a stinger at the end of their body.



Wasps mostly live in nests, but you may see them when you are playing outside.

Sometimes wasps fly into the house, and they cannot find their way out on their own.



If I am at home and I see a wasp I will tell mummy.



Mummy will take the wasp outside so it can fly away.

If I see a wasp, I will try not to panic or scream.



This might scare the wasp or make it angry.



Being stung by a wasp can be very sore and can make people afraid of wasps.

If I am stung by a wasp, I will tell mummy, and she will help me feel better.



Mummy will wash the area that was stung with soap and water or put something cold like an ice pack wrapped in a cloth on the area.

I will take a deep breath if I see a wasp and remember that I am going to be ok.

It is good to learn about wasps.
